In order to make this a pleasant and educational experience for all the GOYANs, we ask you, the parent to please help us adhere to the guidelines and policies. 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2017-2018 - AGREEMENT with the Dance Instructor
St. Andrew GOYA Greek Dance

Welcome all new and current dancers to the 2017-2018 GOYA dance group! I hope you are just excited as I am to embark on a fun and fulfilling year, learning the style, steps, and history of folk dances from all over Greece. To allow for a successful year, the following guidelines and attendance policy must be adhered to in order for our group to grow as a unit and be the best it can be. Please read the entire text and sign at the bottom. You may keep a copy for yourself and hand in a signed copy.

GUIDELINES

- ✓ Wear comfortable shoes (i.e. sneakers or dance shoes). **No sandals, backless shoes, or boots may be worn during practice.**
- ✓ Leave your cell phone in your bag or on the table. You may not carry it in your pocket during practice.
- ✓ Arrive on time, ready to dance. Coming in after the scheduled practice time is not permitted and will not be tolerated.
- ✓ Do not leave practice early, unless your parent/guardian has informed me prior to practice.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

- ✓ If you cannot attend practice, you must inform me **prior to 5pm on the day of practice.** If too many dancers are unable to attend that evening, I will cancel practice and will need to give everyone ample notice.
- ✓ Unexcused absences (not letting me know prior to 5pm) and tardiness are not acceptable and may lead to you sitting out of a dance at the next performance.
- ✓ Missing more than 2 practices before a performance (excused or unexcused) may lead to you sitting out of 1 or more dances at the next performance. This is up to the instructor's discretion and will be discussed with the dancer and parent/guardian.
- ✓ Remember: if you miss practice, you will be behind on the dances. Therefore, you will miss the opportunity to lead or be in the front of the line. Those positions are reserved for the most committed dancers.

You are all young adults, and therefore I will treat you with respect and I expect you to treat your peers and me with the same respect. We are all here for the same reason; to learn and perpetuate our beautiful Greek heritage through dance!
